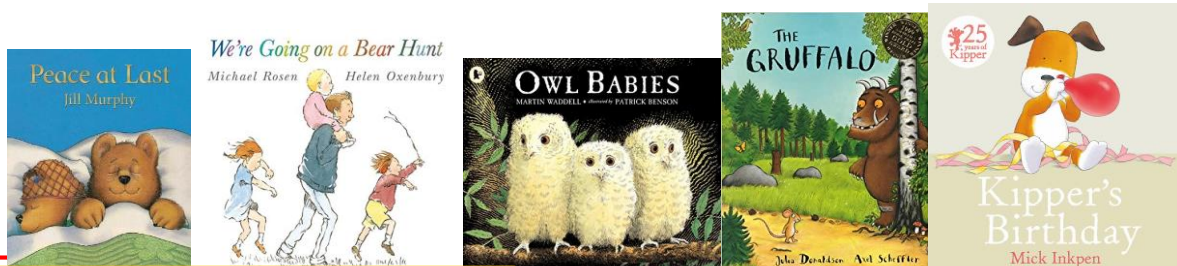

All of the children have settled really well into school and we can see them maturing and growing already.



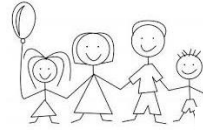
