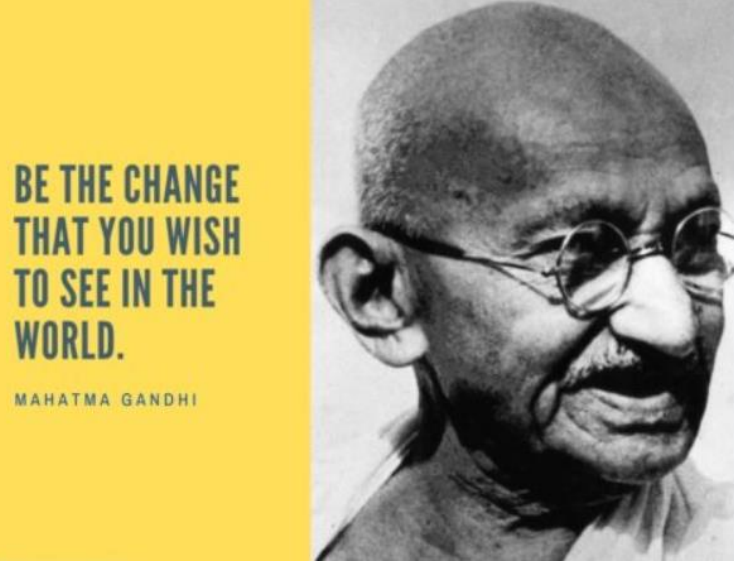




We will explore a variety of charities known, how they fundraise and who/what they help.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Charity	An organization whose purpose is to give money, food, or help to those who need it
Christianity	Christianity is the faith tradition that focuses on the figure of Jesus Christ.
Islam	The religious faith of Muslims, based on the words and religious system founded by the prophet Muhammad and taught by the Quran
Poverty	Poverty is about not having enough money to meet basic needs including food, clothing and shelter
Sikhism	A monotheistic religion, meaning Sikhs worship one God. Guru Nanak taught that one must honor God by honoring others and the Earth
Injustice	Unfair treatment a situation in which the rights of a person or a group of people are ignored

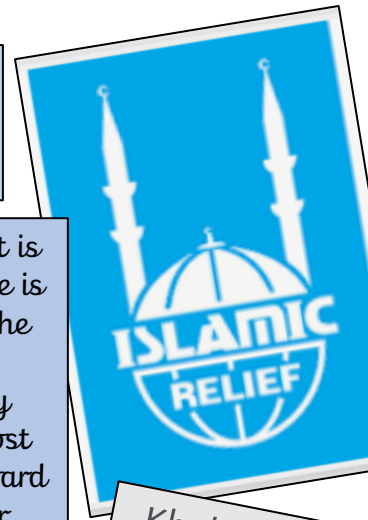
