**The TEN COMMANDMENTS**


- Love God more than anything else.
- Don't make anything more important than God.
- Always say God's name with love and respect.
- Honor the Lord by resting on the seventh day of the week.
- Love and respect your mom and dad.
- Never hurt anyone.
- Always be faithful to your husband or wife.
- Don't take anything that isn't yours.
- Always tell the truth.
- Be happy with what you have. Don't wish for other people's things.




**God's Law says: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.'**  
A man asked Jesus, "Who is my neighbour?" Jesus told this story to show that people of any culture should be treated with kindness.

**The Good Samaritan.**  
Jesus used the Parable of the Good Samaritan as an example of loving those who may not be our friends. Jesus was asked to confirm what he meant by the word 'neighbour'. This is when he told the Parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37), to explain that people should love everyone, including their enemies
