
1990 30 Years ago

Toys that my Grandparents may have played with.




1870 – 1920 Over 100 years ago


Toys from Victorian times.

Theodore (Teddy) Roosevelt was the President of the USA. He went hunting in 1899 but he refused to shoot a bear that had been tied up for him.






Stieff heard the story and made the first Teddy bear in his factory in Germany in 1902.
