Types of Shot

What variations of shot do we now see, in contrast to the early film example?

- Film-makers use a variety of shots, including:
- close-ups;
- · long shots (from a distance);
- mid-shots;
- · low-angle shots;
- · wide shots.

Rather than being in a static, fixed position, a camera may pan and zoom to change the frame of the shot.





Filming and Editing

The next part of the production process is editing your separate film segments into a complete movie using the computer.

Before this stage, everyone should have completed all required filming.

However, there may be some occasions when you realise that an extra segment needs to be captured

You should believe that all your filming is complete before you begin the editing process and your files are ready to be imported into video editing software.

ACTION: Melissa looks for James and Brownie the dog while running on the grass field

CAMERA MOVEMENT: Dolly LOCATION/SCENE Country Side



Full Shot

ACTION: They sit on the grass field and watch the beautiful view ahead of them
