
Key Beliefs

- Muslims believe that there is only one God called Allah.
- They believe Allah is the only ruler of the universe.
- The word 'Islam' means submission and obedience to Allah.

FACT! Muhammad is so special that Muslims says 'Peace be upon him' every time they mention his name.

The Six Main Beliefs

- Belief in Allah as the one and only God.
- 2. Belief in angels.
- 3. Belief in the holy books.
- Belief in the prophets and that Muhammad was the final prophet.
- 5. Belief in the Day of Judgement (the day when Allah decides if a person goes to heaven or hell).
- Belief in predestination (the belief that Allah has already planned out what will happen).

The Muslim Holy Book is called the Qur'an. Muslim's believe that it is the word of Allah. The Qur'an must never touch the floor because it is so special.

All about the Mosque!

The Muslim place of worship is called a Mosque.

Muslim's will prey five times a day in a Mosque or another special place like their homes.

They sit on a prayer mat to pray which is a very beautiful, clean mat to sit on whilst worshipping.

There are no pictures of people or animals in a Mosque at all!

They will take their shoes off and wash their hands, face and feet before entering a Mosque.

There is a special wall in a Mosque which is very important because it faces the direction of Mecca – the Holy place.
