**Spring** is when the temperature begins to get warmer. It takes place over March, April and May.



**Autumn** is when the temperature begins to get colder. It takes place over September, October and November.



**Winter** is the coldest month of the year. It takes place over December, January and February.

<b>Daylight</b>	Daylight is when it is light outside. The amount of daylight changes with each season.
<b>Night time</b>	The time when it is dark outside, after the sun has set.
<b>Light</b>	An energy source that allows us to see the world around us.
<b>Dark</b>	When there is no light.
<b>Sun</b>	A burning star that provides our Earth with light and heat.
