







# R&B

## What is R&B music?

**Rhythm and blues**, frequently abbreviated as R&B or R'n'B, is a genre of popular music that originated in African-American communities in the 1940s. It is a mixture of Soul, Hip Hop and Gospel music. Other RnB singers include Beyonce, Usher, Rihanna and Stevie Wonder.

<b>Introduction</b>	The opening of a song. This can be just instruments or vocal

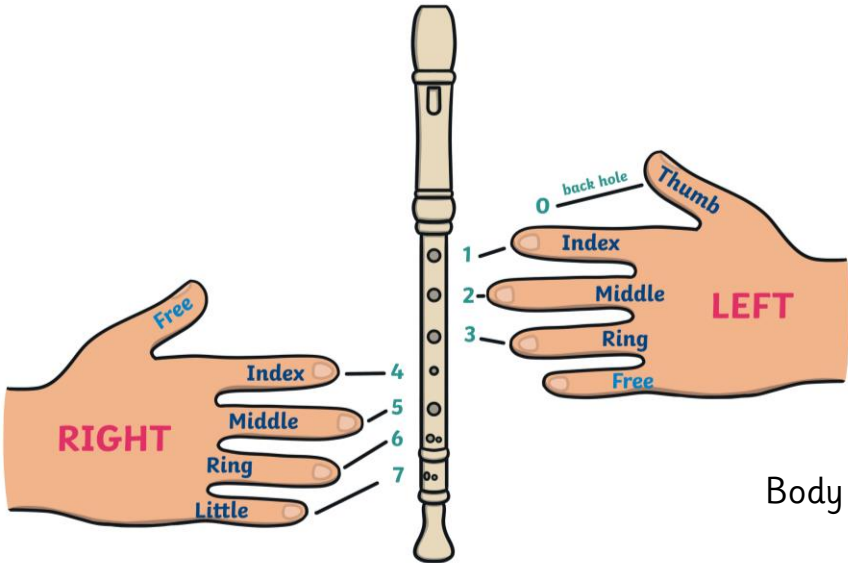
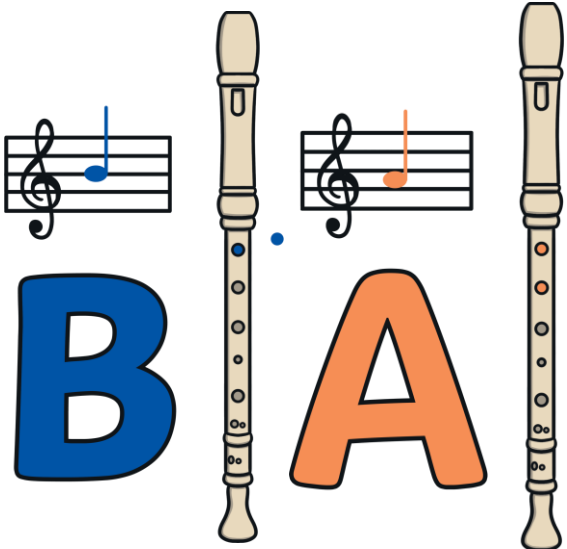


New Vocabulary	
<b>Recorder</b>	A woodwind musical instrument, played similarly to a whistle
<b>Composer</b>	A person who writes music
<b>Structure</b>	The arrangement of a song
<b>Dynamics</b>	The loudness or softness of a piece of music
<b>Melody</b>	A combination of pitch and rhythm

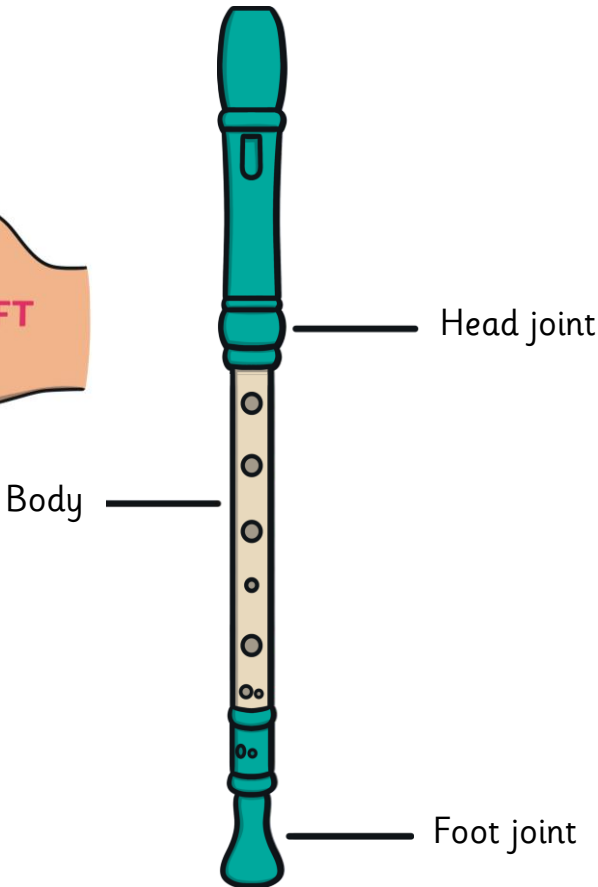


To hold the recorder you need both hands. In the picture, you can see that the left thumb covers the back hole on the recorder. The first three fingers cover the first three tone holes.

# recorder basics



On your right hand, your thumb can go under the recorder to hold for balance. The other four fingers will cover the last four tone holes.



You need to blow softly into the recorder to get the desired sound.

Your lips gently go around the mouth piece. Do not bite the recorder with your teeth.

Cover the correct holes as you blow otherwise it will squeak.
