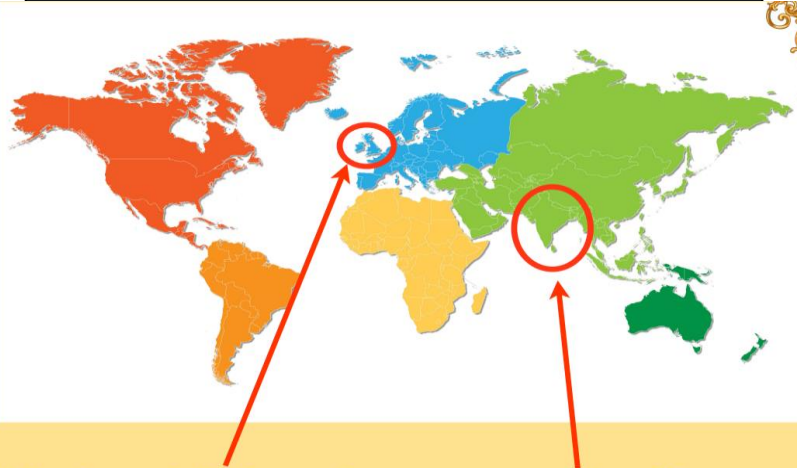

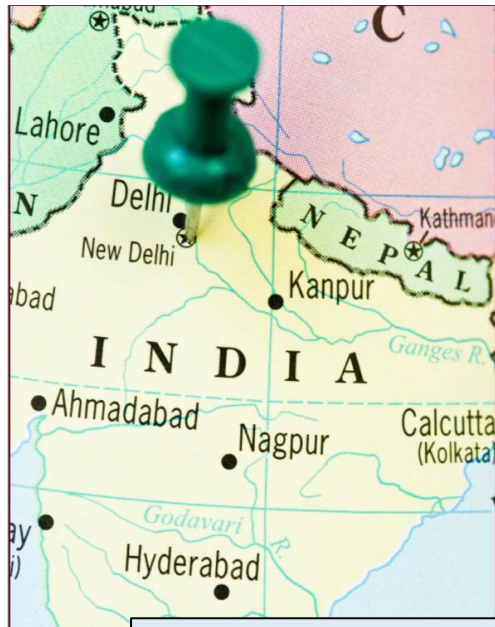


This is the flag of India: The symbol in the centre is a depiction of the Dharma Chakra. It represents the eternal wheel of law.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Climate	Climate means the observed weather conditions and patterns in a particular area, over a long period of time. These patterns are observed over time and then used to predict a country's weather across the year.
Tectonic Plates	The Earth's crust is made up of large slabs of rock, called tectonic plates. Sometimes these plates collide (hit) together with HUGE force. This collision pushes land upwards, forming mountains.
River	A river is a body of fresh water that flows across the land towards the sea.
Human features	Human features are structures that have been built or made by humans. They are not natural objects. The people and the culture of a city fall into this category.
Physical features	Physical features describe the natural environment of a city or area. The climate, land formations, types of animals and plants fall into this category.
Culture	The ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular people or society.
Agriculture	To do with farming. The work of growing crops or rearing animals.



Capital: New Delhi



New Delhi is the capital city of India. The city is found in the district of Delhi. The Indian government is there and the official buildings. There are about 250,000 people living in this city.
New Delhi is in Northern India and is close to the banks of the Yamuna River.

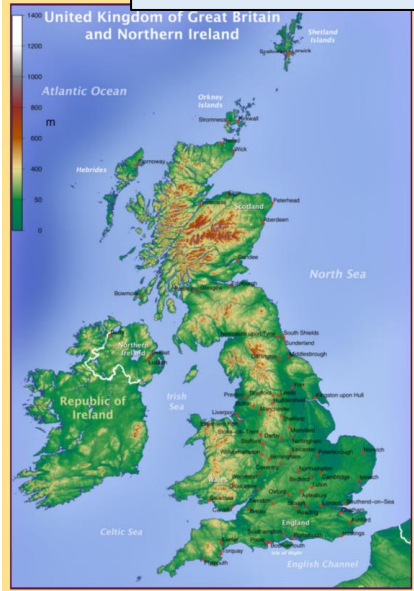


The Ganges River.
