Key Vocabulary

Definition

Cropping

The removal of unwanted areas of an image or picture.

Retouch

To improve or repair an image by making slight adjustments.

Composition

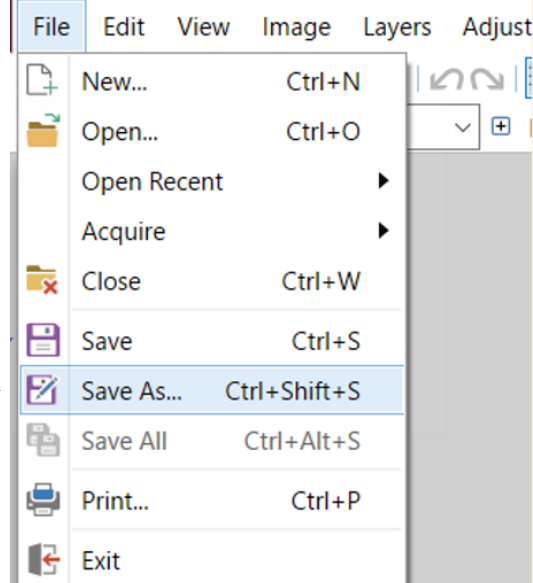
The composition is the parts of the image that make up your overall picture.

Copyright

The legal right for the person who created a piece of art or an image, to own it.

Sharpen

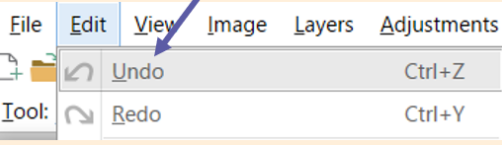
Image sharpening is an effect applied to digital images to give them a sharper appearance.

Black and white



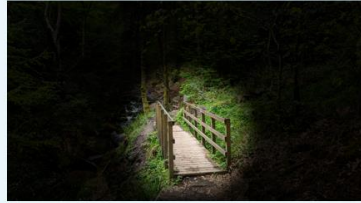
Brightness and contrast

Clone stamp: copies pixels from one part of an image to another



Recolor: used for replacing colours



Magic wand: allows areas of a similar colour to be selected

Retouching.
