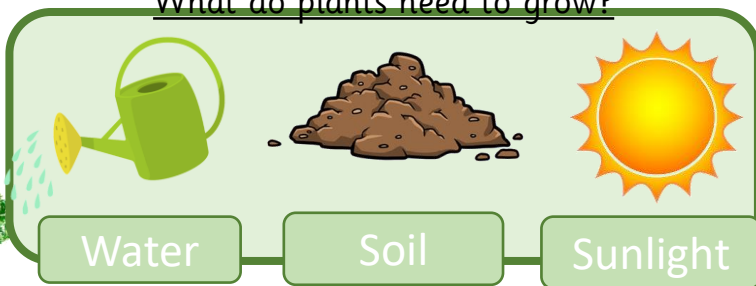




What do plants need to grow?

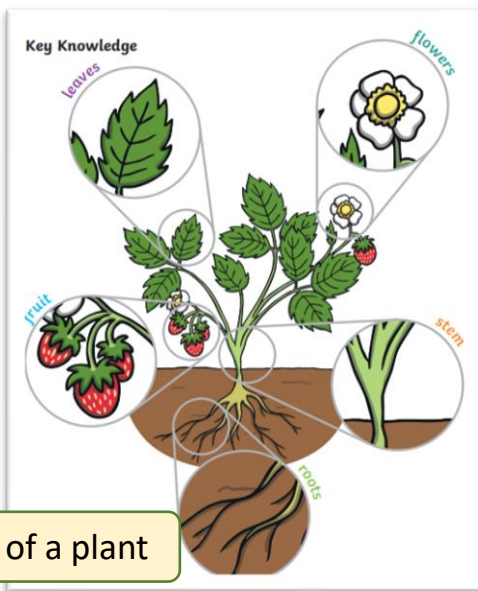

### Parts of a plant

### Key vocabulary

<b>Wild plants</b>	Plants that grows naturally in the wild.
<b>Garden plants</b>	A plant that is planted on purpose in a garden.
<b>Deciduous</b>	Trees that loose their leaves, usually in Autumn.
<b>Evergreen</b>	Trees that don't loose their leaves in any season.
<b>Roots</b>	The part of the plant that is underground and absorbs water and minerals.
<b>Stem</b>	The part of the plant that holds the flower up and carries the water from the roots to the leaves and flowers.
<b>Leaf</b>	The leaves make food for the plant using sunlight.
<b>Flower</b>	The flower attracts insects to help them reproduce (make more plants).
