Tempo	The speed of the music, tempo can change between fast and slow.

Pulse	The steady beat of the song which can be heard when you listen to a song.
Pitch	How high or low a sound is.

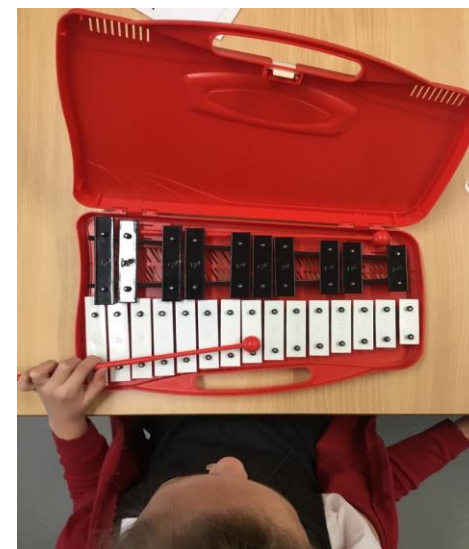
