In 2008, Make You Feel my Love was recorded by Adele for her first album called 19.

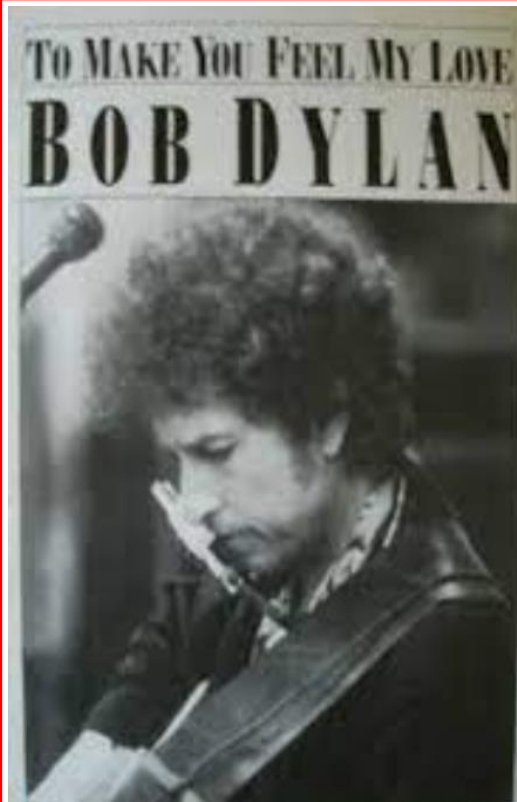
Bob Dylan (born Robert Allen Zimmerman; May 24, 1941) is an American singer-songwriter, musician, and artist. He has been an influential figure in popular music and culture for five decades.

Adele Laurie Blue Adkins (born 5 May 1988), better known as Adele, is an English singer-songwriter and musician.

Ballads

Ballads are very old and were first created in medieval France. They were traditionally songs which told a story and were sung to entertain people.

In modern music, ballads are defined as *slow love songs that are written about romance and have a powerful melody and strong vocals.*

Vocabulary	Definition
Ballad	A slow love song which traditionally tells a story
Interlude	A break between the verses/choruses of a song that includes an instrumental piece
Tag ending	A dramatic change to the last section of a song.
Melody	A selection of notes which makes the main tune in a song.
Dynamics	A change in volume between notes or sections
Timbre	The way a note is held (how long or short)
Texture	How the tempo, melody and other elements come together to create the overall tone of a song or musical composition
