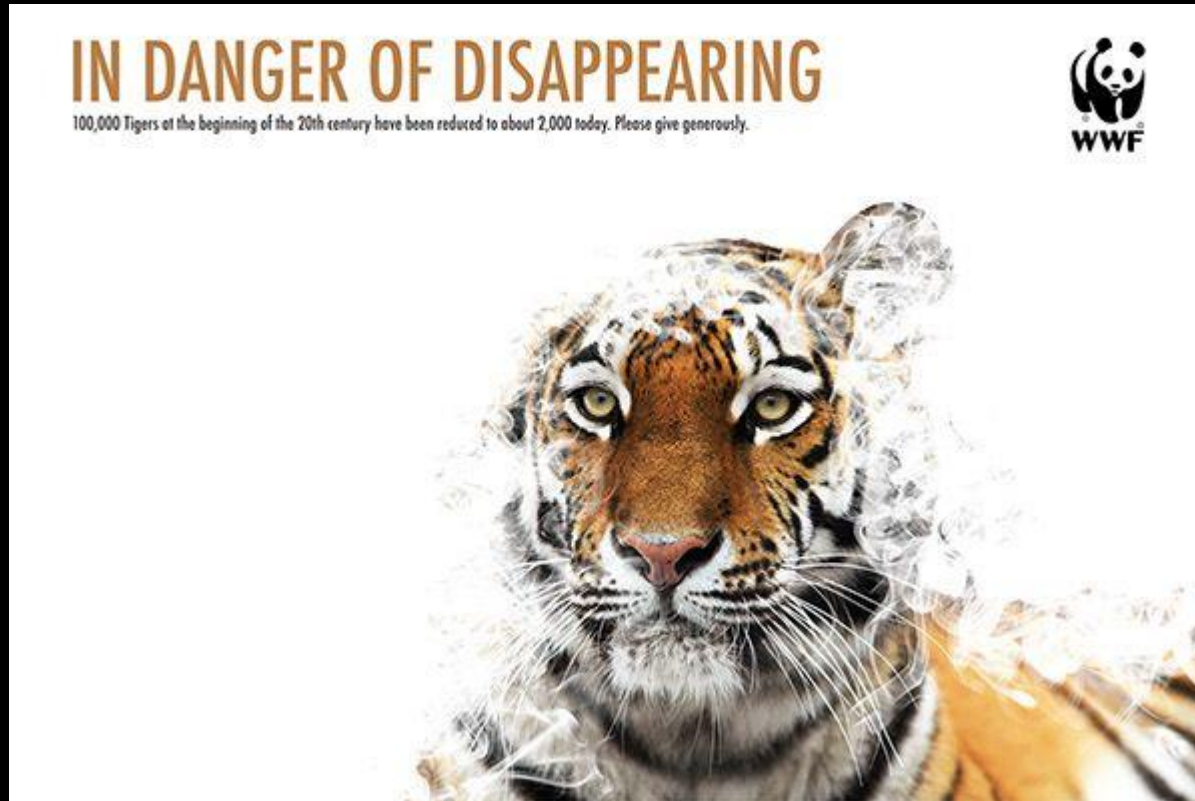




WEAR IT WILD
