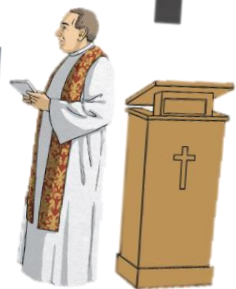

<b>Prayer</b>	A prayer is an act of worship that's like a conversation with your God
<b>Belief</b>	A firm thought that something is true
<b>Mystery</b>	Something that is difficult or impossible to understand or explain.
<b>Divine</b>	Something that is from God or like God.
<b>Feelings</b>	An emotional state or reaction
<b>Christians</b>	A person who has received Christian <u>baptism</u> or is a <u>believer</u> in Christianity.
<b>God</b>	A perfect and all-powerful spirit or being that is worshipped by a religion.
<b>Holy Spirit</b>	The third person of the Holy Trinity; God as <u>spiritually</u> active in the world.
<b>Allah</b>	The Arabic word for God.
<b>Mool Mantar</b>	Is the essential teachings of the Guru Granth Sahib
<b>The Lord's Prayer</b>	A prayer that Christians believe Jesus taught them how to pray to God.



# ISLAM

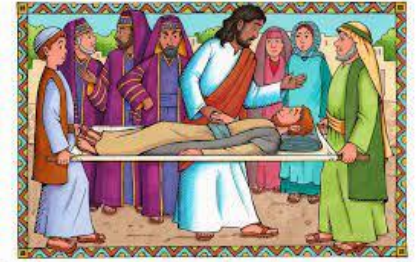
Allah is simply the Arabic word for God – like French people say “Dieu” and Germans say “Gott”. Allah is not a name of God. The Qur’an uses 99 different names for Allah. Each name describes something different about what Allah is like.

 <p><b>AR-RAHIM</b> <b>The Merciful</b></p> <p>He who gives blessings and prosperity, particularly to those who use these gifts as Allah has said, and is merciful to the believers in the hereafter.</p> <p><b>YA-RAHMIN</b> He who repeats this Name 100 times after each Fajr (early morning) prayer will find everyone to be friendly towards him and show easiness to him.</p>	 <p><b>AL-KHALIQ</b> <b>The Creator</b></p> <p>He who creates every thing from nothing and who creates all things with the knowledge of what will happen to them.</p> <p><b>YA-KHALIQ</b> He who repeats this Name at night Allah will create an angel whose duty it is to act righteously for this person until the day of judgement. The reward for this angel's actions will be given to that person.</p>
 <p><b>AL-WADUD</b> <b>The Loving</b></p> <p>He who loves those who do good and bestows on them His compassion. He who is the only one who should be loved and whose friendship is to be earned.</p> <p><b>YA-WADUD</b> If there is a quarrel between two people, and one of them repeats this Name 1000 times over some food and has the other person eat the food, there will be no disagreement between them.</p>	 <p><b>AL-HADI</b> <b>The Guide</b></p> <p>He who guides, gives success and directs His servant to do things beneficial to others.</p> <p><b>YA-HADI</b> He who repeats this Name will have spiritual knowledge.</p>
 <p><b>AL-HAKIM</b> <b>The Wise</b></p> <p>He who has wisdom in all orders and actions.</p> <p><b>YA-HAKIM</b> He who repeats this Name continually [from time to time] will not have difficulties in his work.</p>	 <p><b>AL-GHAFUR</b> <b>The All-Forgiving</b></p> <p>He who forgives all.</p> <p><b>YA-GHAFUR</b> He who has a headache, fever, and is despondent, who continually repeats this name, will be relieved of his ailment.</p>
 <p><b>AL-SALAM</b> <b>The Source of Peace</b></p> <p>He who frees his servants from all danger and obstruction. He who gives His greeting to those fortunate people in heaven.</p> <p><b>YA-SALAM</b> He who repeats this Name 160 times to a sick person will help them regain health.</p>	 <p><b>AL-KARIM</b> <b>The Generous One</b></p> <p>He who is generous.</p> <p><b>YA-KARIM</b> He who repeats this Name many times will have esteem in this world and the hereafter.</p>

Here is the **Mool Mantar**. It is the key summary of Sikh belief in God

Mool Mantar	Statement
There is only One God	Simple words to say that there are not several gods; but impossible to grasp in your mind what "God" means
His Name is Truth	Not just all the right answers to questions, but the True One
The Creator	Cause of the universe and everything in it; keeping the universe going, like a dance is kept going by a dancer
Without Fear	God has no rivals; nothing can harm or threaten God
Without Hatred	God is a good judge, caring and fair
Timeless	Time is the servant of God. God is not tied down by time. God is eternal.
Unborn and self-existent	God is free from birth and death. God has not come to earth in a body. God just <b>is</b> .
Known by the grace of the Guru	You cannot get to God yourself – God must open your eyes.
