Melody	A combination of pitch and rhythm.
Lyrics	The words that make up a song.
Musical	A genre of music, which comes from a film or a play.
Pitch	Whether the singer/piece of music uses high or low notes.
Pulse	The steady beat of the song which can be heard when you listen to a song.

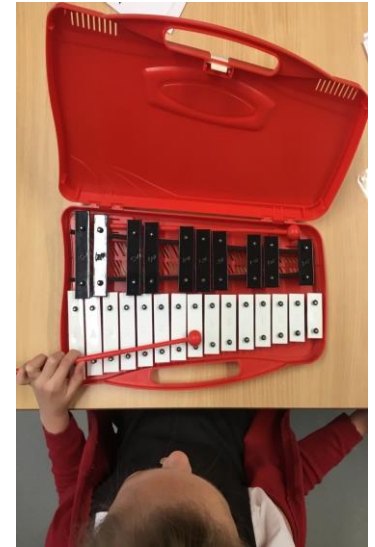
