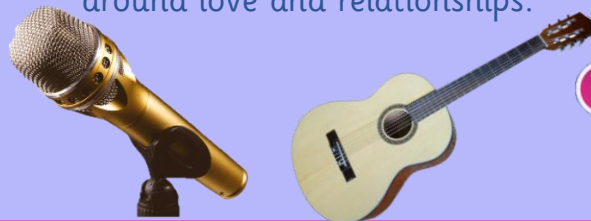


WHAT IS POP MUSIC?

Windway	The narrow slot through which the breath passes
Recorder	A woodwind with a vertical pipe and 8 finger holes and a whistle mouthpiece
Beak	The top end of the recorder that is applied to the lips, not put into the mouth
